Young CEDA's contribution to the programme

Young CEDA will be hosting a session of pitch talks with the aim of creating a dynamic series of up to seven succinct presentations aligned with the overall theme of the conference. The pitch talks will provide students and young professionals with a platform on which to present their ongoing work, expose their ideas to a broad expert audience, and get immediate feedback and inspiration. Young people, in particular students, rarely get the chance to submit a full paper to their peers at professional conferences like CEDA Dredging Days. This event has been organised specifically to give them the opportunity to receive peer input into their ongoing projects.

As always, the social events will be an important part of the Young CEDA programme during Dredging Days 2015. They help to ensure that students and young professionals, attending the conference, have plenty of opportunities to meet their peers and spend some relaxed time with each other. A networking event for students and young professionals is scheduled for Wednesday, 4 November, as an icebreaker for the conference. There will also be a Young CEDA lunch before the pitch talks session on Friday.

Student programme

The Student Programme is a highly successful initiative that enables promising students to attend Dredging Days. Under this programme CEDA offers a considerable number of free registrations to graduate and post-graduate students. They are granted to students who have shown great affinity with dredging technology within their studies.

The free registrations are organised and co-ordinated by Young CEDA, and 15 European universities and institutions of higher professional education will be offered up to three each.
